




Cities With the Highest **Homicide Rates**

St. Louis


With 28.6 murders per 100,000 residents, Chicago's homicide rate placed it ninth among large cities in 2020.


7,057 U.S. SERVICE MEMBERS killed in post-9/11 war operations


- Deployment

Paternal Preconception Exposure To Stress

Stress is often defined as a threat, real or implied, to homeostasis; homeostasis refers to the maintenance of a narrow range of vital physiological parameters necessary for survival (Mcewen, 2000)












