Criminal Investigation Division Population and Culture



CID is an independent federal law enforcement agency consisting of nearly 3,000 personnel assigned to 124 world-wide locations, responsible for felony criminal investigations and operations; war crimes and terrorism investigations, criminal intelligence collection and analysis; cybercrime investigations and operations; multi-dimensional forensic support; and protective service operations for the Secretary of Defense, Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff and other high risk personnel.

- High functioning population
- Motivated
- Inherently distrustful
- Significant stressors



Agent Stressors

- Repeated exposure to "Man's inhumanity to Man"
- Gruesome crime scenes and images
- Pressure to cover leads, bring justice to victims, etc.
- Ostracized from peers or society
- Resource constrains
- Administrative burden
- High professional standards of conduct and public scrutiny







CID Wellness Program Design

- Emphasis on rapport building
- Not documented in EHR
- Brief solution-focused intervention
- Annual and Bi-Annual Wellness checks
- Psychoeducation
- Critical incident response
- Case management/referral assistance



Clinical Presentations in Law Enforcement

Variations in Clinical Presentations

- Flat affect
- Incongruent reported mood vs. observed mood
- Numbed Responsiveness
- Impaired memory with intrusive disturbing images
- Irritability
- Hypervigilance
- Sleep disturbance
- Social withdrawal
- Avoidance

Adaptive Coping Defense Mechanisms

- Repression
- Displacement
- Isolation
- Gallows Humor
- "toughing it out"



Clinical Presentations in Law Enforcement

- Recognizing the Need for Clinical Support
 - Elevated safety risk
 - Symptoms increasing
 - Solution focused brief interventions, problem solving and/or support therapy ineffective
 - Complex psychological issues are identified



Cultivating Peer and Social Support in Law Enforcement

• Presence

- Providers are embedded within the Field Office
- Provide services and advocate
- Battlefield circulation

Rapport Building/Relationship Building

- Acculturation
- Departmental support
- Morale events (include family)
- Cultivating peer support
