


SAVING TWO LIVES; A VETERAN & A SHELTER DOG




VETERANS WITH A SERVICE DOG REPORTED BETTER MENTAL HEALTH





VETERANS WITH A SERVICE DOG REPORTED LESS ABSENTEEISM FROM WORK DUE TO HEALTH




VETERANS WITH A SERVICE DOG REPORTED BETTER DAILY EMOTIONAL WELLBEING




